# Marriage Records Available at the Medina Library

## MARRIAGE INDEXES

### DAR BOOK

Early Marriage Bonds of Ohio, Medina County 1818-1865.  
Two volumes, one volume for the Grooms (Direct) and one for the Brides (Indirect), arranged alphabetically by initials. Gives the date of the ceremony, officiant, volume and page of the marriage record.

### MICROFILM

#### Card File Index

covers 1818-1965  
Microfilm rolls #17-24 cover the brides, rolls #24-31 cover the grooms.  
Information on the cards includes: name, spouse's name, date of marriage, name of officiant, certificate number, probate judge's name, volume and page number of the marriage record. Later cards include age, residence and birthplace. Best index.

## MICROFILMED MARRIAGE RECORDS

### Marriage License Affidavits 1833-1861

a third party, or sometimes the groom, would swear that they knew of no obstruction to the marriage, i.e.; the bride and groom were of age to marry, were not first cousins, and that neither had a spouse living. These affidavits are not indexed and are arranged chronologically on microfilm rolls #32-36.

### Marriage Records 1818-1898

include brides' and grooms' names, date of marriage, name of officiant, sometimes the location, and later, the date it was recorded.  
After 1868, the license application/affidavit information is included with the record.  
Indexed as listed above.  
Microfilm rolls #32-38.

### Marriage Records 1899-1965

in addition to the information provided on the earlier records, these include place of birth, occupation, age, residence and names of the parents.  
Microfilm rolls #39-52.
